



- 4) Steps Required

3) Utility Clearances for Water Work

A) Horizontal Clearances

1) When available 5' clearance is requested between water facilities including appurtenances and other utilities; 3' clearances are required.

2) Service installations and all water appurtenances are required to have a 5' clearance from sanitary sewer house connections.

B) Vertical Clearances

1) A vertical clearance of 6" is required between utilities.

*Any abandonment of existing services 3" or greater will require a Public Works Developer's Agreement.
