Progress Update – August 2006**

Project Progress

Work is underway for the improvements to the Jones Falls Force Main and Pressure Sewer. The project improvements and water main relocation efforts are proceeding with minimal disturbance.

Three Month “Look-Ahead”

Aug 2006:

- 42" Pipe Installation: On Broadway from Federal Street to (approx.) North Avenue
- 48" Pipe Installation: On 33rd Street from Chestnut Avenue to Keswick Road

Sept 2006:

- 42" Pipe Installation: On Broadway from Federal Street to (approx.) North Avenue (continued)
- 48" Pipe Installation: On 33rd Street from Keswick Road to (approx.) Gilman Terrace/ Stony Run Interceptor

Oct 2006:

- 42" Pipe Installation: On Broadway between North Avenue and Harford Road
- 48" Pipe Installation: From Huntingdon Avenue and 31st Street to Remington Avenue
- 54" Pipe Installation: On Broadway between North Avenue and Harford Road

The use of the ball fields as a staging area will be concluded by summer 2008. All fields, bleachers and tress will be fully restored.

Claim Procedures

All complainants have 180 days from the date of incident to file a claim. Complainants must request a claim form from the Law Department by calling **410-396-3400**, or simply download the attached PDF document, [Law Department Claim Form](#). If you contact the Law Department by phone, a claim form will be mailed the same day. All completed claim forms must be sent back to the Law Department for review. The Law Department will forward completed claim forms to the contractor's insurance company for review. Copies of personal videos or pictures should be sent to the Law Department along with the complainant's completed claim forms. All complainants will be notified by the Law Department of final decision.
